Dear Mr. Lambert:

This is in follow-up to your letter of January 10, 2008, concerning CIA's destruction of video tapes of interrogations of terrorism suspects. At that time you reported that your detailed response would have to wait until other investigations are completed.

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has informed us that they have concluded their investigation of the tapes destruction. While DOJ is not filing any criminal charges in this case, NARA must still receive a report of CIA's own investigation. At this time, NARA is requesting a report on CIA's own findings and a date by which NARA can expect a final determination whether an unauthorized destruction has occurred. If CIA determines that an unauthorized destruction has occurred, then CIA must submit a full report to NARA as described in 36 CFR 1230.14.
