IS SLATED FOR SYDNEY BETWEEN 17 AND 21 FEBRUARY 1971  
AND A THIRD NATIONAL MORATORIUM FOR 30 APRIL 1971.  
DURING AUGUST 1970 ARTHUR JOHN LLOYD CIRCULATED  
LISTING OF PROPOSED FOREIGN INVITEES TO ANTI-WAR  
CONFERENCE. IT IS PRESUMED THAT ALL ON LIST HAVE
